



2017 SYNAPSE CSIRO RESIDENCIES - GUIDELINES

The Australian Network for Art & Technology (ANAT) and CSIRO Manufacturing are calling for applications for the Synapse CSIRO Artists' Residency program.

The residencies are open to **Victorian-based artists** working in any artform, and will take place for three months full-time (or part-time equivalent) at the CSIRO's Clayton facilities during 2017.

ANAT and CSIRO have identified three research areas that we believe have the right mix of compelling science and researchers committed to working with artists and providing the necessary level of support.

The three are:

[3D printed structures](#)

[polymer coatings for cell adhesion](#)

As the residencies have a creative research focus, it is not expected that they will result in the production of new work. ANAT will pay the residency artists a fee of \$800 per week and contribute towards materials costs. CSIRO Manufacturing will provide access to staff, equipment, facilities and resources.

Tertiary students, including PhD candidates, are ineligible to apply if the proposed residency in any way contributes to the achievement of your academic qualification. If you are unsure about this requirement, please contact us to discuss your particular circumstances.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The selection criteria comprises:

- Originality and innovation of the proposed project;
- Artist/s professional track-record and their familiarity with the proposed area of inquiry.

HOW TO APPLY

Please submit the following, via email, in your application:

1. Completed and signed Application Cover Sheet (attached)
2. ONE-PAGE Proposal, which includes:
 - a. A description of the proposed research
 - b. A statement about how the artist expects to benefit from the residency
3. ONE-PAGE Budget
An example budget is available to guide applicants - please contact us to receive a copy.
4. Support material - no more than TWO of the following:
 - Four images in digital format
 - Four minutes of video (URL only)
 - Four minutes of audio (URL only)
 - One interactive work
 - Four URLs**Select support material that best demonstrates your artistic practice.**
5. Summary Artist's CV (no more than TWO pages).

Your application must be received by **5pm, (Australian CST) on Monday 3rd April 2017**.
You will be notified of the outcome of your application by Wednesday 12th April 2017.

To ensure a fit between the artist and the CSIRO research team, **it is strongly recommended that interested artists discuss their project proposal with us prior to applying.**
